Topic Overview – London’s Burning

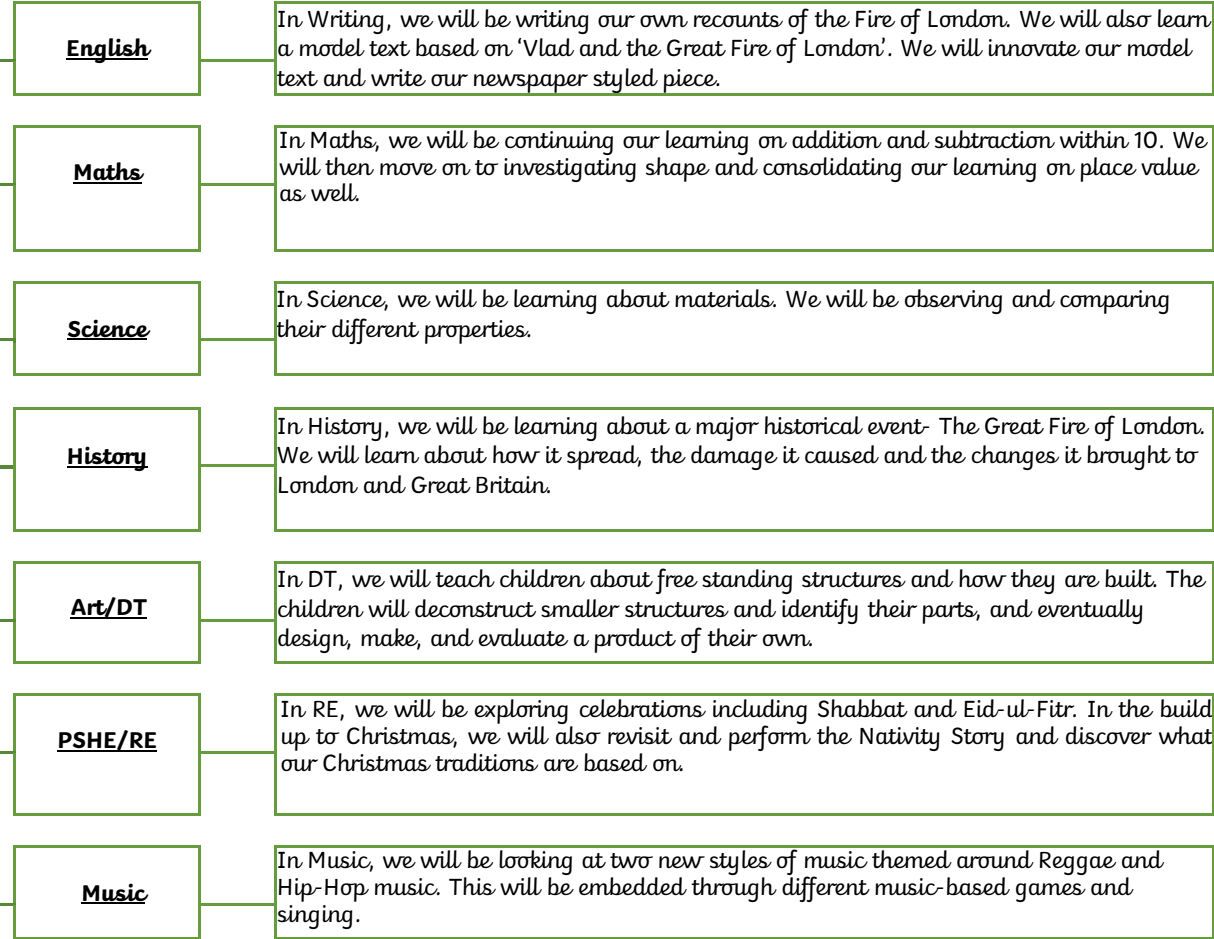
In Autumn 2, students will be gripped by this significant historical event from the 17th Century! We will learn about the events which led up to the Great Fire of London, including looking at famous landmarks which were destroyed and then rebuilt. We will compare fire-safety from the past with modern day, using replica artefacts to enhance our historical enquiry. We will begin looking at primary sources, focusing on Samuel Pepys diary, which was written during the Great Fire!

Big Bang! Children will be investigating our own miniature fire. They will explore the environment and work out what might have occurred! They will theorise the events that took place before we explore the actual reason!
