

Year 3 Autumn 2 –Who is the Greatest?

Topic Overview

Our Learning Overview

Who is the Greatest?

English

In English, we will be learning about The Iron Man by Ted Hughes, by the end of term, we will have written a recount in Hogarth's point of view.

Maths
