Topic Overview

This term you will be learning about the ancient Egyptians. In this topic we will be learning about the civilisation of ancient Egypt and how they were renowned for their knowledge; pyramids; trade and social hierarchy. Children will learn how Egyptians communicated, lived and worked, and the rise and fall of such an interesting empire.

Our Learning Overview

Tomb Raider

Writing

In Writing, we will continue exploring the features of the written word. Consolidate grammar and punctuation understanding. Children will focus on learning about historical fiction and newspaper reports.

Maths

In Maths, we will be consolidating our understanding of multiplication and division. We will reviewing fractions: equivalent and improper fractions; ordering and comparing fractions and adding subtracting fractions.

Science

In Science, we will learn about different forces, explore how mass is not related to the physical size of an object and understand the force of gravity.

History

In History, we will be learning about the ancient Egyptian civilisation and how they were renowned for their knowledge; pyramids; trade and social hierarchy. We will also focus on their ongoing legacy.

DT

In DT will focus on movement and rotation. We will look at ancient Egyptian technology as inpiration to plan and create a moving toy.

RE

In RE our focus question will be: If God is everywhere why do we have places of worship?
We will focus on the importance of Churches, Synagogue and Mandirs.
