



Year 3 Summer 1 - Failed Caesar!  
Topic Overview

In Summer 2, the children will learn all about the Romans - this will be across their Reading, Writing and History lessons. In writing they will be reading the 'Roman Diary: The Journal of Iliona'. The children will be revisiting topics learnt in Year 3 to consolidate and deepen their learning. The children will be taking part in a debate as to what they think the Romans brought to Britain and what we use today.

Our Learning Overview

Disaster Strikes!

<b>English</b>	In Writing we will be writing our own flashback narrative based on a day in life of a Roman. We will be learning about Iliona's life as a young Roman child.
<b>Maths</b>	In Maths, we will be completing our unit on time and exploring shape and statistics. The children will learn about pictograms and bar charts and even create their own!
<b>Science</b>	In Science, we will be reflecting on what we have learnt so far this year; Animals including humans, Plants and Rocks, Lights and Magnets.
<b>History</b>	In History, we are going to be looking at <i>Did everyone like the Romans?</i> We will explore who the Romans are, what they brought to Britain and what happened when they invaded Britain.
<b>Art</b>	In Art children are going to be looking at collages. We will also be taking part in an Art and Diversity fortnight where children will create their own mosaic.
<b>PD/RE</b>	In Personal Development the children will be learning about health and relationships. We will look at our emotions and values to build healthy relationships. In RE, children we will be exploring what it means to be a Christian in Britain today.
<b>Music</b>	In Music, children will be exploring how music shapes our way of life, as they look at a range of different musical styles.
