

Year 4 Summer 1 - The House of Wisdom

Topic Overview

In Summer 1, in History, we will learn about the Ancient Islamic civilisation and how the legacy of and continuing influences of early Islam links to society today. The children also explore the Golden Age of Islam and its impact on technology, architecture, travel and trade.
