

Year: 5 Term: Summer 1 Topic: Lest We Forget

This term you will be learning about 'Lest we Forget. In this topic we will be learning about WWI and WWII. Students will be looking at primary and secondary sources to aid in research while empathising with an evacuee's thoughts and emotions. Children will gather facts and research and have a detailed understanding of the global effects of WWII.

Our Learning Overview

<u>Writing</u>

This term, we will be learning about the Second World War and the impact it had on people from all walks of life. The children will be writing their own evacuation stories and newspaper reports.

Maths

First we will focus on coordinates, including translation. We will expand the children's understanding of geometry by investigating a variety of shapes and their properties. We will finally focus on statistics, and deeping knowlege of tables and line graphs.

Science

In our Chemistry topic, the children will learn about the properties of materials. Explore what makes specific properties useful and how different properties can be useful.

History

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The children will learn about the precursors to the Second World War. The children will find out about the geography and history of WWII, which countries were involved and their leaders. We will explore important chronological events and their impact.

<u>Art</u>

In Art, we will focus on the artist Henry Moore and improving sketching skills to develop depth and perspective. We will also use mediums including oil pastels.

<u>RE</u>

In R.E, our focus will be on Christianity and what it means to be a Christian today.

In computing we will become App Designers - by creating an app using Keynote.

In Spanish we will be focussing on learning to name other clothing and shopping. In Music, we will continue to work with the brilliant Mrs Masheder, exploring a variety of musical genres.
