



## Year 6 Summer 1 - Make a Difference

### Topic Overview

Children will explore, evaluate, and discuss the challenges environmental scientists face to slow down global climate change. Pupils will then research and suggest alternatives and solutions that make a difference to their world and their children's world.

### Hook Lesson

### Our Learning Overview

#### Make a Difference

#### Writing

We will be studying 'Booked' by Kwame Alexander. It is a novel written in verse and the children will be writing their own poems and narratives inspired characters and events in the book.

#### Maths

In maths, children will be recapping skills learned throughout the year.

#### Reading

In reading, we will be exploring weekly texts to consolidate the children's retrieval, inference, predicting and summarising skills.

#### Science

The children will build on their knowledge from Lower Key Stage Two where they will begin to learn the main parts of the circulatory system and be able to discuss the functions of each of the organs. The children will take part in scientific enquires where they will be using equipment with precision and accuracy. They will also recognise the importance of a healthy lifestyle and will learn how drugs and alcohol can have a negative effect on the human body.

#### Geography

We will explore the issue of climate change, research its effects on the planet and our future.

#### Art

We will be using digital media to compare methods and approaches in artists' work. They will collect and store visual information using digital cameras. They will explore street art: walk around the local area to identify examples of graffiti, discuss different artists. The messages they are trying to convey the purpose of the artwork.
