Topic: Off With Her Head!

This term our children will be learning about the Tudors and their impact on the modern-day UK. Children will learn about key historical figures and events in British history. In science, we will explore how our bodies change during puberty in preparation to become an adult.



### Our Learning Overview

Off with Her Head

English

In English, we will continue to explore the features of the written word. Consolidate grammar and punctuation understanding. Children will focus on the play, Macbeth by William Shakespeare and write a balanced argument as to whether Lady Macbeth was the real villain.

Maths

In Maths, we will continue our learning of decimals and introduce percentages. The children will also be consolidating their understanding of area and perimeter.

Science

The children will be investigating the six stages of human development, from conception to old age. We will be investigating how the human body grows, develops and changes.

History

In History, children will learn about key historical figures and events in Tudor dynasty and its lasting impact on our modern lives.

Art

In Art, we will focus on Tudor busts using plasticine to create 3D busts.

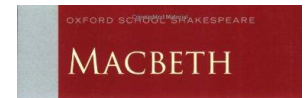
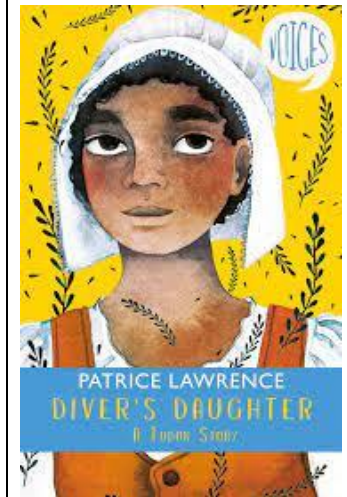
RE
