Topic Overview

In Summer 1, we are taking a journey back in time to 1066 where we will learn about the battle of Hastings and how castles came to be. We will learn about different types of castles and their features, who lived in them and why they were built. Along the way, we will learn about significant people like William the Conqueror and important moments in history like when the Magna Carta was created.

Our Learning Overview
