



Year Group: 1 Term: Spring 2

Big Question: What effects do the changes in weather have around the world?

This half term the children will be naming different types of weather and recognising that weather changes across the year and creates seasons.

Hook

The children will be going on a weather adventure, visiting weather stations and investigating different types of weather!

Subjects

English

In English, the children will be exploring the book Meet the Weather. For the incidental outcome, the children will be writing a description of a weather type including adjectives related to our five senses. For their final outcome, the children will be writing their own rhyming weather poem!

Maths

In Maths, we will be learning about place value within 50. We will also be exploring length and height, as well as weight and volume.

Science

This half term, the children will be learning about the human body exploring different organs and how our senses can help us. We will also be looking at animal classifications, and what different types of animals eat.

Geography

This half term the children will be naming different types of weather and recognising that weather changes across the year and creates seasons. The children will also be identifying how weather can affect people, animals, and places around the world and how people adapt to it.

Art

In Art, we will begin to explore printing. Children will identify and create patterns using a range of printing methods, focusing specifically on block printing their own skyline.

Music

In Music, we will be learning the song Round and Round, which is sung in a Bossa Nova Latin style. We will be focusing on pulse, rhythm and pitch.

Computing

In Computing, pupils will be learning about coding - finding out what it is and how it is used in daily life.

R.E.

In RE, we will be continuing our exploration on the terms 'sacred' and 'holy'. We will consider why places are considered as sacred and holy. We will also be continuing to explore lots of different places of worship.

P.E.

In PE, the children will be undertaking a games unit where they will learn how to throw and catch accurately as well as practising simple tactics in a game. Children will also be learning how to handle equipment to strike objects. Our PE days are **Wednesday** and **Friday**.

In Personal Development, we will be continuing to learn about living in the wider world, being part of a community and what this means to us.
